LEAF Scholarship Application

Thank you for your interest in applying for a LEAF Scholarship.


The LEAF Scholarship Program is a merit based scholarship awarded to undergraduate students attending an accredited community college or state university and majoring in a horticulture-related program leading to a career in the landscape contracting industry or related fields. Applicants should show sufficient academic progress, work experience and extracurricular activities to demonstrate their intent to become a landscape industry professional.

1. Any student attending an accredited California community college or state university majoring in a landscape-related program is eligible to apply. **Students attending a community college must carry a minimum of 9 units to qualify. Students at a state college or university must carry a minimum of 12 units to qualify.** Certificate programs alone are not eligible. *Please note that this is a new eligibility requirement for the LEAF scholarship.*
2. Scholarships are available for students who will be continuing at their current college or who will be transferring to another accredited college in the fall of 2026. Recipients will receive the funds only after providing official PROOF OF ATTENDANCE for the fall semester.
3. Three letters of recommendation are required. One of these three letters must be from a CURRENT instructor or counselor. The other two can be from a CURRENT OR RECENT employer, club/activity advisor, previous instructor or church leader. If reapplying, please supply **current** letters.
4. A copy of your college transcript(s) from each college attended is required.
5. Applications will be independently reviewed by the members of the CLCA Auxiliary Scholarship Selection Committee. Criteria includes career goals, extracurricular activity, work experience, GPA in major, financial need and letters of recommendation. Scores will be tallied and recipients chosen accordingly.
6. Any information submitted (application information, employment, letters of reference, etc.) may be verified.
7. Mailed applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2026. Electronic applications must be received by April 15, 2026. NO EXTENSIONS. The applicant is responsible for getting completed application to LEAF by the deadline, including letters and transcripts. It is recommended the entire application package is submitted at the same time.
