Don't let the drought deter your Trophy Awards entries. The judges reward well-done irrigation systems and recognize the limits local officials and conditions may place on water usage.

In fact, creative compliance with local ordinances and water agency restrictions frequently results in a higher score from the judges, who want to recognize those who work within the rules to contribute to a beautiful California.

As one judge noted during California's last drought, brown is the new green.
